There's a brochure in my office titled "Working for You." We often hand it out at community events or at the office to first-time visitors. It lists the state services my staff and I can help you with, such as PennDOT matters or Property Tax/Rent Rebate applications.

My District Office is one of the places you can turn to when you are seeking information or assistance from state government agencies. In some cases, we are limited in how much we can intervene, but most times, we can make an inquiry, help you navigate the process, or connect you with someone to assist you further.

We are here for everyone. Older Pennsylvanians may need assistance completing an application for aging and older adult services. New parents may just need a contact at the State Treasury so they can start a 529 College Savings Plan. During the pandemic, many people contacted our office for the first time - for assistance with an unemployment claim, neighborhood food banks, or small business grants.

As COVID presents ongoing challenges in the new year, my staff and I will continue to serve you in a safe and healthy environment. That means we may have to shift to curbside office hours or work remotely during surges. We may also have to host virtual and outdoor events to share state and community resources. Whether in-person or virtual, we want you to know that we are **still here and still working for you.**

# Investing in Our Community

The 2021-2022 budget included more than \$30 million in funding for community gun violence prevention programs.

Part of the job of a state representative is to know the needs of residents and apply that knowledge to bringing back resources and funding for services and projects in the district that matter to us all.

In the last 6 months of 2021, more than \$8.5 million in state investments were made in the 195<sup>th</sup> District. These projects included preservation of iconic structures, like the Coltrane House, support for community gardens and more.

# Redistricting

Every 10 years, data from the U.S. Census provides information for the redrawing of legislative and congressional district lines in all states. In December, the Pennsylvania Legislative Reapportionment Commission voted on a preliminary map of proposed legislative districts (\*see graphic). The purpose of redistricting is to provide elective districts that maintain equal representation based on population growth – to ensure that everyone’s vote counts equally. Pennsylvania is divided into 50 state Senatorial and 203 state House seats. We are the 195<sup>th</sup> Legislative District.

Regardless of the district lines, I am committed to representing your voice in Harrisburg. My office will remain available for all your state government needs.
