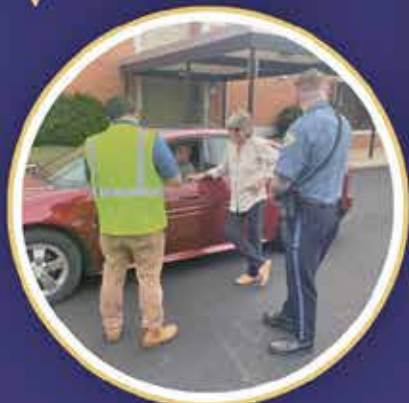

# HIGHLIGHTS

- No new taxes
- **Over \$1B increase** for Pre-K to 12 education funding
- **\$30M increase** for Career and Technical Education
- **\$100M** for Public School Facility Improvement Grants
- **NEW \$3M** investment for menstrual hygiene products in schools to address period poverty
- **Over \$15M increase** for Community Colleges
- **Over \$140M** for grants, scholarships, and other programs to make higher education more affordable
- **\$20M** for student teacher stipends
- **\$70M** for attainable housing initiatives
- **\$16.5M increase** for anti-violence investments and after-school programs
- **\$20M increase** for county based mental health services
- **NEW \$2.5M** for legal services in eviction proceedings

# Rep. Guenst 2024 GRANTS

Over \$3 million in grants so far this year!

- Abington Township (\$15,000)** - for police training and recruitment of law enforcement officers
- Salem Adult Citizens Center in Abington (\$52,000)** - to enhance programs and services
- Hatboro Borough (\$850,000)** - for a Memorial Park Improvement Project
- Hatboro Borough (\$347,627)** - to restore and remediate a swale
- Lower Moreland Township (\$433,442)** - to construct sidewalks along Byberry Road
- Huntingdon Valley Fire Company (\$169,000)** - to purchase new rescue tools
- Upper Moreland Township (\$897,375)** - to rehabilitate the Maryland Road Bridge
- Upper Moreland Township (\$225,000)** - for Woodlawn Park development
- Eastern Center for Arts and Technology (\$85,000)** - to purchase new equipment to train students

## Harrisburg Happenings

LGBTQ+ individuals deserve the same protections in housing, employment, and public accommodations as every other Pennsylvanian. HB 300 passed the House and is now awaiting a vote in the Senate. This legislation will prohibit discrimination in our state based on sex, sexual orientation, or gender identity/expression.
