That's in addition to my annual coat drive, which provided nearly 600 coats to kids in need; our "Kicks for Kids" program, ensuring every child had shoes for back-to-school; and my summer swimsuit giveaway, helping kids enjoy the pool on hot summer days.

You know that as keep rolling through 2026 I'll keep fighting for our community -- and working hard to help families, seniors and all our neighbors as much as I can.

HOME HEATING ASSISTANCE IS AVAILABLE!

Don't suffer unnecessarily this winter! If your home is cold and you need help, FREE assistance may be available through the state. LIHEAP heating assistance grants can help keep your home warm and safe during the coldest months. The program, which remains open until April, provides cash grants ranging from \$200 to \$1,000, depending on your household size, income, and fuel type. The cash grant is a one-time payment. The grant will be sent directly to your utility provider or fuel company to be credited on your bill. Contact my office for help!
