I remain firmly opposed to the Shawnee-Walker 69-kV Transmission Line Project.

After attending the Delaware Township meeting in 2023, I reaffirm my opposition, as many of the same serious concerns remain unresolved. Constituents continue to raise critical questions, particularly regarding undisclosed deed restrictions and the lack of clear, transparent responses from your company, and those questions have not been adequately addressed.

My primary responsibility is to the health, safety, and economic well-being of the residents I represent. At this time, I have significant concerns regarding:

- The potential decrease in property values
- Environmental impacts to local ecosystems and water resources
- Disruption of recreational use and open space preservation
- Negative effects on the Township's rural character and scenic landscape
- Public health and safety risks, including concerns related to electromagnetic exposure

These are not minor issues, they go directly to quality of life.

The people of this region have chosen to live in a rural community for a reason. They value their environment, their open space, and their way of life. I stand with them, and I believe their concerns outweigh the justification for this project in its current form.

Until these concerns are meaningfully addressed, I will continue to oppose this project.
