

SEPTA Main Line Bridges Project

Easton Road Bridge Rehabilitation & Keswick Avenue Bridge Rehabilitation and Superstructure Replacement (March 2025 through Early June 2025)

As part of SEPTA's continuing efforts to bring its bridge structures into a state of good repair, SEPTA's contractor is scheduled to perform work on the SEPTA bridge over Easton Road and the SEPTA bridge over Keswick Avenue in Cheltenham and Abington townships between March and early June.

SEPTA Bridge Over Easton Road:

Rehabilitation efforts include structural repairs, including concrete repairs to the abutment walls, center pier support and bridge superstructure as well as waterproofing of bridge superstructure. In addition, crews will perform partial platform replacement and repairs at Glenside RR Station.

Road Closures For Easton Road Bridge Work:

Easton Road between Mount Carmel Avenue and Glenside Avenue to be closed in early-to-mid-March 2025 for approximately 6 weeks. Road to reopen prior to the Downtown Glenside Arts Festival, set for May 3, 2025.



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SEPTA Bridge Over Keswick Avenue:

In addition to concrete repairs to the abutment walls, the bulk of this work will be a rapid bridge superstructure replacement. Work will take place during a 78-hour shutdown of Regional Rail service on Memorial Day weekend.

The existing Keswick Avenue bridge will be carried off-site to a nearby staging/prep area where it will be broken down. New bridge will be brought to staging area where it will be assembled. Assembled bridge will be transported to project site and lifted into place.

Road Closures For Keswick Avenue Bridge Work:

Keswick Avenue between Mount Carmel Avenue and Paxson Avenue to be closed from approximately May 19th through May 30th, 2025. Also expect partial closures of Mount Carmel Avenue between Rices Mill Road and Keswick Avenue during

Memorial Day weekend (May 24th through May 26th).

***Access to local businesses will be maintained throughout the road closures/detours. ***
