Join us for Story Time with a VSC educator!

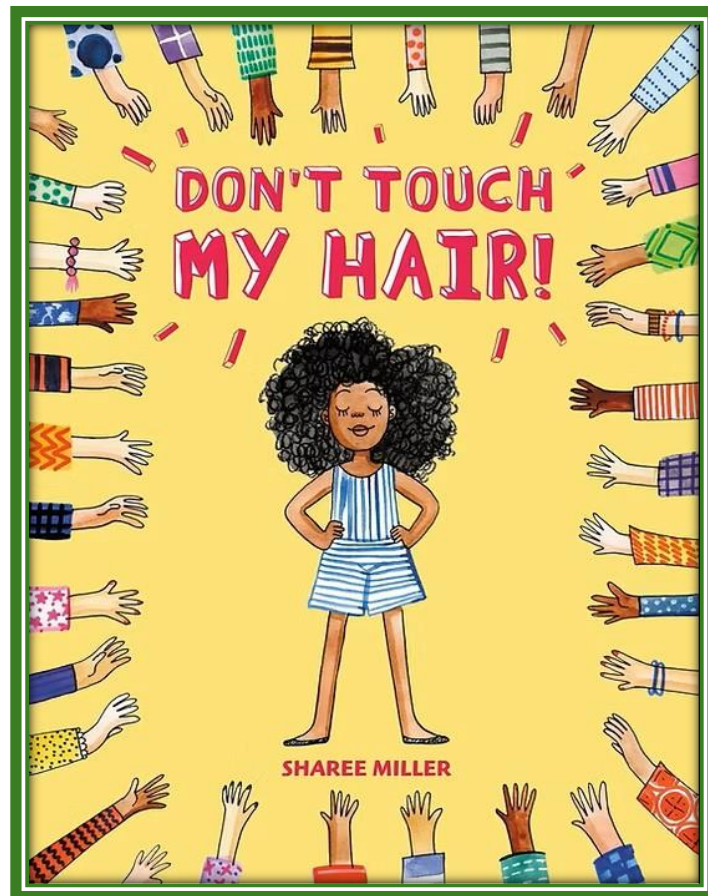
We will read "Don't Touch My Hair" by Sharee Miller. Kids will up and move, practicing saying stop and setting boundaries.

Join Andrew Dolan for a Towamencin Bird Town Event, coordinated with the Valley Forge Audubon Society, as he leads a walk through his "home patch," a 77-acre park where more than 150 bird species have been recorded to date – 146 of them by Andrew! He knows the park intimately, including all the tucked-away spots where we hope to spot warblers and other fall migrants that stop to rest and feed as the fall migration ramps up.

All experience levels, abilities, and ages are welcome, including children when accompanied by an adult. Please bring binoculars if you have them. The walk is about 2 hours long and follows paved, well-maintained natural paths.

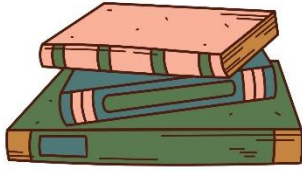
