National Night Out

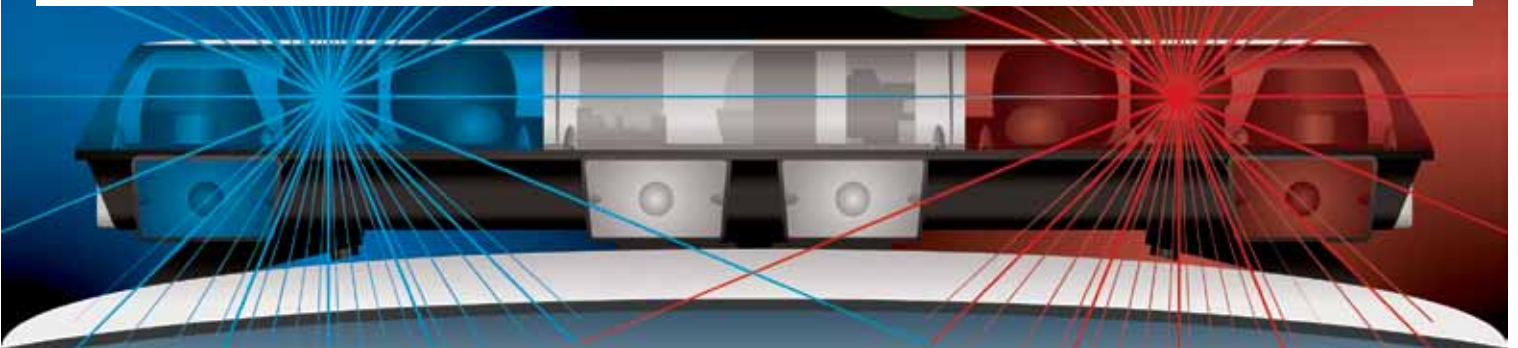
