In Our Community

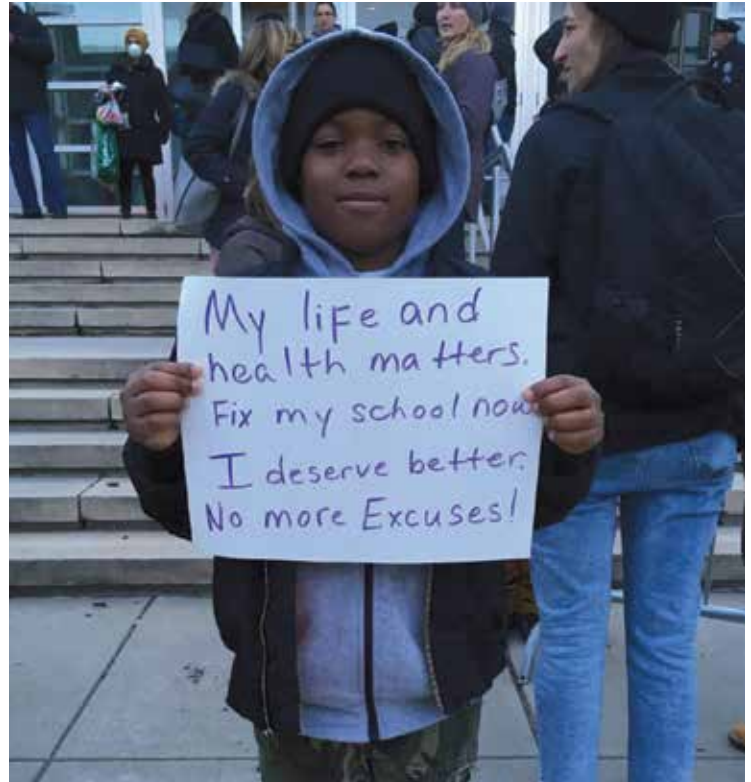


In November, I announced a \$20,000 grant for the Fumo, Whitman and South Philadelphia branches of our Free Libraries. With these funds, our libraries will be able to offer a variety of programs for older adults, adults, teenagers and children.

I was also able to help the Pennsylvania Horticultural Society get a \$56,000 grant to help renovate the Emily Street Garden. This garden has been integral in helping local Burmese and Bhutanese communities rekindle pieces of their cultures in South Philadelphia.



I brought the Pennsylvania House Democratic Policy Committee to Furness High School in South Philly to show firsthand why we must fix the dangerous school conditions our children and teachers are facing every day.

I was glad to meet many of you at my recent three community breakfasts – thank you to our wonderful volunteer pancake flippers!

The state's Property Tax/ Rent Rebate Program deadline is Dec. 31. The program provides rebates up to \$650 on rent or property tax paid by Pennsylvania residents age 65 or older; widows and widowers age 50 or older and residents with disabilities 18 or older.



The income limit is \$35,000 a year for homeowners and \$15,000 annually for renters. Half of Social Security income and all Social Security cost-of-living increases are excluded.
