Working to Help Pennsylvanians Retire

When it comes to saving for retirement, it has become increasingly more difficult for workers to put funds aside when a vast number of Pennsylvanians do not have access to employer-sponsored retirement plans, worker wages continue to be stagnant, and the cost of living and unforeseen expenses are

still budgetary concerns for many, instead of preparing for enjoying stress-free senior years.

To combat this, a bipartisan bill with support from the Pennsylvania Treasurer is being introduced to establish **Keystone Saves**, a voluntary employee retirement savings program that expands

access to private sector individual retirement plan accounts to the more than two million workers who currently do not have retirement plans through their employer. While in Harrisburg, I will continue to fight for fair wages and for workers to have the peace of mind that they will be able to comfortably retire.
