LEGISLATIVE UPDATE

THE 2025-26 STATE BUDGET

Governor Shapiro signed our balanced, bipartisan 2025–26 state budget into law in mid-November, which, unfortunately, is significantly past its June 30th due date. During this impasse, my House colleagues and I spent quite a few nights and weekends in Harrisburg to put forth solutions – we sent three different budget proposals to the Senate before they put a proposal to a vote. But critically, we stayed at the negotiating table, putting *people over politics* and passing a balanced, bipartisan budget that **invests in our Commonwealth**.

In the wake of federal funding cuts that are impacting families across our community, it was very important to me to **preserve the state services people rely on most**. As the only state in the Northeast with a growing economy, this budget invests in our schools, infrastructure, and

people to further our economic successes and ensure that this growth benefits all of us.

Our final budget provides \$2.27 billion in additional funding over last fiscal year, representing a 4.7% increase for our schools, roads, businesses, and much more. It doesn't raise taxes or tap into PA's \$8 billion Rainy Day Fund – it even adds a new tax break, the Working Families Tax Credit, which gives working people an automatic 10% match of the federal Earned Income Tax Credit. That can amount to \$1,000 or more back every single year for working families with children

I'm proud of what we were able to accomplish, and I look forward to the impact these efforts will have on our community.



MY LEGISLATION

H.B. 1063 protects online shoppers from "Grinch Bot" fraud

Since my last newsletter in July, I've introduced a new piece of legislation. In October, the House passed my proposal to prevent scalpers from using software to buy items online in bulk for the sole purpose of reselling them at exorbitant prices.

Consumers like you have the right to a fair marketplace, and I first introduced this measure two years ago because it is the state legislature's duty to help protect it. The bill targets a type of software used by modern scalpers called a "Grinch Bot," which bypasses online sales platforms' controls to automatically buy products in bulk and then resell them at prices far higher than the original seller intended.

House Bill 1063 would stop Grinch Bots by making it illegal to use software that bypasses sales platforms' security measures and other technological controls designed to enforce purchasing limits. The bill is now eligible for consideration by the Senate.

BRINGING YOUR TAX DOLLARS HOME

I am proud to have helped bring more than \$1 million back into our district so far this year! These grant funds will support community institutions, enhance education, provide services for seniors, and help keep our neighborhoods safe.

This includes:

- \$325,000 to fund STEM education and after school programs at North **Montco Technical Career Center** and the North Penn Boys & Girls
- \$282,000 to improve local roads and storm water management in
- \$142,000 to support and improve

local senior centers including Generations of Indian Valley. The Spark Center and Jaisohn Wellness Center.

- \$108,000 for our local fire & EMS services.
- \$100,000 for historic preservation of the Lansdale Freight House.
- \$55,000 to help the Lansdale VFW renovate their facility.





STATE-RELATED REMINDERS

PRIMARY ELECTION: MAY 19

As we approach the **Primary Election** on **Tuesday, May 19**, here is some key information to remember:



PROPERTY TAX/RENT REBATE: APPLY BEFORE DEC. 31

To ensure that as many Pennsylvanians as possible receive the relief they are entitled to, the deadline for older adults and Pennsylvanians with disabilities to apply for rebates on rent or property taxes paid in 2024 was extended to December 31.

Funded by the Pennsylvania Lottery, Pennsylvania's Property Tax/Rent Rebate Program supports homeowners and renters across the state. The program provides a rebate ranging from \$380 to \$1,000 for eligible older adults and people with disabilities 18 and older. For tax year 2024, the maximum household income is \$46,520, with only half of Social Security income counting toward the limit. You can pick up an application booklet or get in-person help at my office or apply online at mypath.pa.gov. Please contact us at (267) 768-3671 to schedule an appointment.
