## **Grants Coming to our District**



I've been working hard to advocate for funding for our district. **I'm thrilled to share these recently awarded grants totaling over \$2 million – and more are on the way!**

**\$750,000 to Warminster Township Police Department**, to implement much-needed tech upgrades.

**\$520,000 to Warrington Township**, to complete necessary modifications to the retention basin at Palomino Farms.

**\$250,000 to Warrington Township Police Department**, to purchase 40 body cameras and 20 in-car camera systems.

**\$240,000 to Ivyland Borough**, to support important safety and accessibility improvements, including a new crosswalk across Jacksonville Rd. at Willard Ave. with a flashing warning sign, an ADA-compliant ramp and sidewalk connecting Ivyland Community Park to Ivyland Commons Park, and park enhancements like benches, trash cans, and landscaping.

**\$155,380 to North Wales Water Authority**, to purchase two public water system vehicles to service Warrington Township and meet new EPA and PA DEP mandates.

**\$90,000 to Bucks County Chief Science Officers**, to implement a county-wide STEM initiative.

**\$35,000 to the William Tennent Robotics Team**, to assist with operating costs.
