HELPING OUR REGION RECOVER

The American Rescue Plan will be a huge help to our region and state. The plan brings an estimated \$22 billion in relief to Pennsylvania, including \$382 million for Allegheny County and a total of \$8.55 million for the municipalities in the 38th District. It also includes \$35.78 million for our school districts.

Expediting access to COVID-19 vaccines is also a vital component of the American Rescue Plan – vaccines that are critical to saving lives and bringing this deadly pandemic to an end.

TAX ASSISTANCE

My office was proud to host an AARP tax preparation site to assist our seniors with their federal, state, and local tax returns.

Through a partnership with the Internal Revenue Service, AARP volunteers were able to process over 350 tax returns this tax season.

For planning purposes, AARP starts accepting appointments on the Tuesday following Martin Luther King, Jr. day every January. Please call the office at that time next year if you or someone you know could benefit from this service.

As a reminder, the deadline to file 2021 local, state, and federal taxes has been moved to May 17th.



VETERANS' ASSISTANCE
